Irene is the founding CEO and a board director of the ScaleUp Institute, a private sector, not-for-profit company focused on making the UK the best place in the world to scale up a business. A former senior banker at Standard Chartered, Irene held European and global managing director roles, developing a range of their corporate, institutional and transactional bank services, as well as undertaking some key M&A activities across their global footprint.
